


| <p>Working together for success: In the classroom</p> | <p>*Provide high quality and rigorous standards-based instruction. *Deliver differentiated instruction and varied learning strategies leading students to reach and exceed grade level academic expectations. *Provide homework that will reinforce classroom instruction. *Hold high expectations for all students. *Monitor each student's progress and provide varied learning opportunities for students which will enable them to meet academic expectations. *Provide parents with timely reports on their child's progress. *Keep quality student assessment data. *Provide necessary assistance to parents so they can help with homework assignments. *Be timely in responding to parents' communication. *Encourage parent attendance at school events.</p> | | |
| <p>Working together for success: At home</p> | <p>*Provide support and encouragement to their child(ren). *Participate in learning opportunities in regard to understanding child's grade level standards. *Engage in opportunities at home and in school to support learning. *Monitor homework completion and understanding. *Monitor academic progress by reviewing graded work, assignments, academic reports, and FOCUS. *Encourage my child's efforts and be available for questions. *Attend parent conferences and meetings. *Communicate with the teacher if questions should arise. *Keep an open line of communication between home and school. *Read all notices, newsletters and flyers sent home. *Attend school events, conferences, and family workshops as often as possible. *Participate in decision making at school. *Reinforce class lessons and expectations through regular communication with your child(ren).</p> | | |
