

At home \*Participate in decision making at school. \*Reinforce class lessons and expectations through regular communication with your child(ren). \*Be attentive and prepared for class each day. \*Put forth best effort both academically and with behavior. \*Complete homework on time. \*Be responsible for own learning. \*Review Working together teacher feedback to continually improve performance. \*Strive to improve work and attitude by setting high goals. \*Ask clarifying questions. \*Review and revise work. \*Let parent/teacher for success: know if you are struggling. \*Show interest in academic progress. \*Practice the 7 Habits and be a PBA leader. \*Follow school rules and policies. \*Attend school regularly, complete all Student responsibility assignments, work cooperatively with classmates, be respectful to all adults and peers. PBA staff will: \*Keep an open line of communication between teacher, students and their families. \*Regularly communicate with families on student performance. PBA parents will: \*Communicate with my child's teacher on a regular basis. \*Read all communication that is sent home. \*Communicate academic/behavioral expectations to child. \*Keep **Communication:** school informed and up to date on contact info. Staying informed PBA students will: \*Give parents/guardians all notices and information received at school each day. \*Let parent and teacher know if you are struggling. \*Keep an open line of communication with teacher.
