### The House System is...

- A way of organizing students designed to establish a strong community culture based on the PBA's 7 Leadership Laws (Paws Laws).
- Students work together to achieve common goals.

### Jaguar Pride

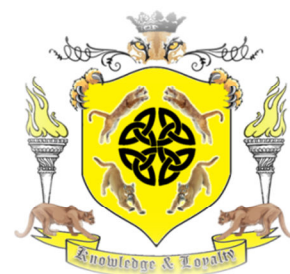
- Shield Color = Red

## House Merit Its Measured Against a Point System...

### Basic Point System – 3 points for...

- Showing leadership
- Ready for class and instruction
- Celebrating another student
- Student was in complete uniform

### Spirit Week Point System...

- 2 points – Participating in Spirit the entire week
- 25 points – The Most Spirit

### Classroom Leadership Point System...

- 15 Points – Pass Test 90% or above
- 20 Points – No Detentions/Referrals/Suspensions
- 50 Points – Parent Volunteer

King/Queen Panther House Leaders (the 2-3 Teachers Per House) earn points for their Pride by...

- Implementing small group lessons and project-based learning in the classroom
- No referrals from your class
- Participating in extra-curricular activities and duties
- Contacting parents and writing a positive review about the school
- Having the most school spirit
